CKLA SKILLS & KNOWLEDGE

Skills Unit 1:

- Will start this in the coming weeks.
- Students practiced reading, spelling, and writing words following the -all, -oll, and -ull spelling pattern.

Ask your child: To write and read the following words...

- ball, call, small, doll, roll, poll, pull, skull, full

Knowledge Domain 1: Fairy Tales and Tall Tales

- Students listened and discussed three tall tales: Paul Bunyan, Pecos Bill, and John Henry! They identified elements that tell us these are tall tales and for all the larger than life exaggerations in these stories.

Ask your child: Which one was their favorite and to retell any of these tall tales / describe the exaggerations in them!

MATH

Unit 1: Addition and Subtraction within 20

- Students explored odd and even numbers, adding doubles equations, and writing equation chains.
- **Ask your child to**
 - count by 2s to thirty or higher
 - tell you even and odd numbers and explain how they know they are odd or even
 - write their doubles equations for you. **Bonus** if they can sing the doubles song from class!

SCIENCE & SOCIAL STUDIES

Social Studies Unit 1: What is a community?

- Students reviewed about places they can live work, play, and solve problems in a community. They also learned about the Constitution and statue of liberty for Constitution day
- **Ask your child:** What they know about communities, the constitution, or the statue of liberty from this week!
