CKLA SKILLS & KNOWLEDGE

Skills Unit 1:

- Students practiced reading, spelling, and writing words with the -tch spelling pattern spelling the /ch/ and -dge spelling /j/ sounds after short vowels. See examples below and have your child read and write the following words...
 - words with the -tch spelling pattern spelling the /ch/ sound: witch, batch, fetch, sketch, patch, hitch
 - words with the -dge spelling pattern spelling the /j/ sound: dodge, fridge, smudge, bridge, ledge, pledge

Knowledge Domain 2: Early Asian Civilizations

- Students listened to informational readings on the significance of the Great Wall of China and how Silk was first created—both contributions from Ancient China!
- Students also drafted a informational book about different contributions/inventions from Ancient China, like paper, block printing, farm tools, and ways of writing (calligraphy).
- Ask them: What inventions did the people of Ancient China create? How did these inventions make their civilizations better? How do we use these inventions in our world today?

MATH

Unit 2: Addition within 200

- This unit focuses on place value, adding 2 digit numbers, and addition fluency within 100.
 - How many hundreds, tens, and ones are in a numeral.
 - Representing a numeral in a drawing with a quick draw (boxes, 10-sticks, and circles).
 - Writing an expanded quation of a numeral to show the value of each place value. (100+30+4=134)

• Ask your child to

- o write a number/numeral under 200
- Tell you how many hundreds, tens, and ones are in this numeral
- o Draw a Quick Draw of this number for you
- O Write an expanded equation of this numeral.

SCIENCE & SOCIAL STUDIES

What is geography?

Students explored what is geography. Students learned about the 7 continents, sang a song about them, identified physical features on maps, features on political maps, and drew their own maps!

 Ask your child: to name and sing the 7 continents song. Bonus if they can locate them on a map!
