Dear Parents and Community Members:

We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER), which provides key information on the 2022-23 educational progress for Kingsley Middle School. The AER addresses the complex reporting information required by federal and state laws. The school's report contains information about student assessment, accountability, and teacher quality. If you have any questions about the AER, please contact Heather Miller for assistance.

The AER is available for you to review electronically by visiting the following website **Annual Report**, or you may review a copy in the main office at your child's school.

For the 2022-23 school year, schools were identified based on previous years' performance using definitions and labels as required in the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). A Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) school is one that had at least one underperforming student subgroup in 2022-23. An Additional Targeted Support (ATS) school is one that had a student subgroup performing at the same level as the lowest 5% of all schools in the state in 2021-22. A Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) school is one whose performance was in the lowest 5% of all schools in the state or had a graduation rate at or below 67% in 2021-22. Some schools are not identified with any of these labels. In these cases, no label is given. Our school has not been given one of these labels.

The 2022-23 school year was another successful year for the students, parents, and staff of Kingsley Middle School. Our students' NWEA and MSTEP scores continue to be above local and statewide averages and student performance on other national and local assessments is also above average. We believe that Kingsley Middle School continues to be a highly effective school because of three crucial staff characteristics:

- Our educational team believes that all students can learn and they provide differentiated and cooperative opportunities for students to learn in ways that are most engaging for each individual.
- Kingsley Middle School has adopted and aligned instruction to the Common Core State Standards (CCSS) in math and language arts, the Next Generation Science Standards (NGSS) in science, and College, Career, and Civic Life (C3) Framework in social studies. We are providing students with a guaranteed viable curriculum in all academic areas.
- Our teachers collaborate in cooperative and purposeful teams known as Professional Leaning Communities in which their teaching practices are reviewed

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and reflected on with other professionals. This is a direct reflection of our mission statement, "**Together** We Believe and Achieve!"

Some key challenges that we have observed in reviewing our 2022-23 data include a significant drop (16%) in reading achievement in 5th grade. To help accelerate achievement in reading for our 5th graders, we have created additional sections of Read 180, our Tier II reading program for our readers who are just below grade level in reading. An additional intervention that has been implemented in 5th grade is a heavy emphasis on reading in social studies class, as well as several tiered reading intervention groups during our intervention period (WIN – What I Need) so that most 5th graders are receiving intervention or enrichment in reading. We observed less significant drops in reading achievement in 6th grade and 7th grade. In these grade levels, we are also providing our struggling readers with reading intervention through Read 180 and reading intervention in their WIN period.

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HIGHLIGHTS OF THE ANNUAL REPORT

- Kingsley Middle School was rated an overall "A" school and a Reward School. A Reward School, as defined by the state of Michigan's A-F accountability system, are those that receive the highest grade (an "A") in either student proficiency, student growth, or on the similar school proficiency comparison. KMS received an "A" in proficiency, growth, AND similar school comparison for 2021-22 school year.
- Kingsley Middle School's combined *proficiency* in math and language arts was 60%. Our combined *growth* in math and language arts was 60%.
- 8th Grade students who took the PSAT scored 68% proficient in language arts and 69% proficient in math.
- 52% of 5th graders and 55% of 8th graders demonstrated grade level proficiency on their MSTEP Science test; both scores above state and ISD averages.
- 24% of 5th graders and 40% of 8th graders demonstrated grade level proficiency on their MSTEP Social Studies test; both scores above state and ISD averages.

PROCESS FOR ASSIGNING PUPILS TO THE SCHOOL

Kingsley Area Schools assigns students to three schools based only on the grade level of each students. All students enrolled in 5th-8th grade who attend as district residents or as school of choice students are assigned to Kingsley Middle School.

STATUS OF THE 3-5 YEAR SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT PLAN

Kingsley Middle School is in full compliance with the Michigan Department of Education school improvement plan model to develop and implement the school improvement plan. Kingsley Middle School is working with our ISD, Northwest Education Services, to implement MICIP and our school improvement goals. The MICIP allows school to develop goals and strategies to address areas in need of improvement such as in curriculum and intervention.

DESCRIPTION OF EACH SPECIALIZED SCHOOL

Kingsley Middle School is not a specialized school (magnet school, special education, target school, or other).

DESCRIPTION OF THE CORE CURRICULUM & IMPLEMENTATION

In 2010 the Michigan Department of Education adopted a comprehensive set of national standards for English Language Arts and Mathematics or CCSS (Common Core State Standards). The district curriculum council approved a timeline for implementation that includes collaboration with Northwest Education Services (the ISD) for the purpose of realigning K-12 curriculum from the GLCE's (Grade Level Content Expectations) to the new CCSS. All grade levels 5-8 began the process of reviewing the new CCSS during the

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2010-11 school year and have achieved full implementation. Middle school content area teachers accomplished the critical task of reviewing and aligning the Language Arts and Math standards to the new CCSS at the end of the 2013 school year.

In 2013, the State of Michigan began revising the content expectations for social studies and involved educators from local, ISD, university, and state-level organizations. The project was focused on updating the existing 2007 standards around the charge of "clearer, fewer, and higher." A final version of our state standards in social studies was achieved in 2019. Our middle school social studies teachers have since reviewed, revised, and realigned our social studies curriculum to reflect these new standards.

In 2015, the State of Michigan adopted the Next Generation Science Standards (NGSS) as their core curriculum. These standards include cross-cutting concepts, disciplinary core ideas, and science and engineering practices. Our middle school science teachers have since reviewed, revised, and realigned our science curriculum to reflect these new standards.

The middle school teaching staff is highly dedicated to a collaborative and purposeful curriculum alignment process. The teaching staff, working in grade level and content area teams, engage in regular alignment by using release days derived from professional development funds.

Educators and classroom teachers from Michigan school districts have been involved in the development and/or review of Michigan's standards. The expectations were designed to ensure that students receive seamless instruction, form one grade to the next, leaving no gaps in any child's education. More importantly, they set high expectations in literacy and mathematics so we can better prepare all K-12 students for the challenges they will face in a global 21st century. AGGREGATE STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT RESULTS

Kingsley Middle School administers NWEA assessments to all students in grades 5-8 in reading and mathematics three times each school year. The results of the assessments are provided to parents at the end of each year. Students are provided with their "target" or "RIT" score before each assessment and are provided with coaching on their growth and improvement. The assessments are also the most critical data that are used to determine if students are struggling and may be in need of intervention. The chart below identifies the percentage of students who are scoring above grade level expectations on the Fall, Winter, and Spring (if available) administrations of the NWEA assessment.

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
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PARENT/TEACHER CONFERENCES

Kingsley Middle School holds two parent teacher conferences during the school year, in addition to an Open House held in August. The purpose of conferences is to discuss the students' progress, highlight areas of success, clarify areas of concern, discuss ways to improve those areas, and to strengthen the working relationship between home and school. Each grade level invited 10-15 parents to scheduled parent conferences which was then followed by an evening of "open house style" parent conferencing. Over 95% of parents attended their fall *scheduled* conference meetings. Additional conferences are held throughout the year as requested by teachers, parents, and/or administration.

As you review this report, you will see that Kingsley Middle School has had another successful school year. This success was due to the dedicated staff, supportive community, and the amazing student body that make up our school. We plan to continue this tradition by being pro-active in helping meet our students' individual academic needs. We will continue to utilize NWEA, a computerized student testing system that will allow us to better monitor student achievement. This valuable data will help teachers adjust their teaching strategies and plan for intervention and acceleration which will allow students to experience more academic growth. We take great pride in working with you to educate our students to become productive, responsible citizens and life-long learners.
