1st marking period testing: We have been busy testing your child in reading, writing, math, phonics and more! We cannot wait to share our data with you at conferences.

Science: We have been exploring plants and animals, and what living things need to survive.

Math: We have been learning how to solve and write addition and subtraction equations in the vertical and horizontal form. We've also been working on story problems and using different methods of solving them.

Writing: We continue to learn about nouns, verbs and adjectives. We are also working on proper letter formation and sentence structure.
